Notices of Race

1. Venue

The Nevada Yacht Club (NYC) will be holding its Single-Handed and Jack and Jill 2011 Race which will consist of races on the lower basin of Lake Mead. The race schedule will be as follows:

Jack and Jill	Sunday, October 9, 2011	10:00am	11:30am

Competitors meetings will be held on the patio of Lake Mead Marina.

2. Rules

NYC's Single-Handed and Jack and Jill Race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of PHRF, and the Sailing Instructions (SI). The use of autopilots and tiller tamers is permitted in the interest of safety.

3. Eligibility and Classes

There will be one class with PHRF ratings. The races are open to all competitors with boats meeting the requirements of the Southern California PHRF by-laws.

4. Entries

Entry forms can be printed from the website or will be available on the dock at Lake Mead Marina before Competitors meeting on the day of the race. Registration is closed after Competitors meeting on the day of the race.

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions for the Single-Handed and Jack and Jill Race will be available at the Competitors meeting before the race and / or online at www.nevadayachtclub.com

6. Courses

The courses to be sailed shall be specified in the sailing instructions. Additionally, at the competitors meeting, there will be further instructions. Course information may be modified on the water and communicated by the Race Officer on Channel 72.

7. Scoring

The Single-Handed and Jack and Jill and Jack and Jill is scheduled for a minimum of three races. At least one race must be sailed to constitute the series. The series will be scored using the RRS Appendix A Low Point System with the following designations and point assignments.

8. Prizes

Trophy will be awarded to top finisher and medals for other competitors.

9. Other Information

Lake Mead and the surrounding area is designated a National Recreation Area and as such is subject to the rules and regulations of the National Park Service.
